Our Breast Disease and High-Risk Clinic at the STHS Women's Pavilion offers a range of services for patients who have an elevated risk for developing breast cancer. This includes those with personal or family history of breast cancer, a Tyrer Cuzick Score of 20% or higher, a positive BRCA gene and other risk factors.

Our highly trained team provides multiple services along with those included below:

- Individualized risk assessment and plan of care
- Genetic testing
- Risk-reducing surgeries and medication options
- Routine breast imaging every six months
- Chemoprevention
- Breast exams
- Medical management





What is Tyrer Cuzick Risk Score?

• The Tyrer Cuzick Risk Score is an assessment performed to identify your 10-year risk and your lifetime risk of developing breast cancer which is displayed on your mammogram report. To determine your risk score, we calculate a series of questions regarding your personal and family history. Patients that score 20% or greater are considered to be at a higher risk for developing breast cancer.

High-Risk Clinic at STCC

The High-Risk clinic at St. Tammany Cancer Center – A Campus of Ochsner Medical Center is available for patients who have a personal or family history of cancer.

Personal or family history of:

- Pancreatic cancer
- Ovarian cancer
- Metastatic prostate cancer
- Colon cancer before age 50
- Endometrial cancer before age 50
- Bilateral kidney cancer
- Breast cancer
- Rare cancers
- Ashkenazi Jewish ancestry





Services offered at High-Risk Clinic at STCC

Our highly skilled and dedicated team includes a genetic counselor, medical oncologists, nurse navigators and radiologists.

Our clinic staff will collaborate with patients to offer a personalized, multidisciplinary approach to care that includes monitoring strategies specific to our patient's needs.

- Cancer screening
- Cancer risk assessment
- Genetic testing and counseling
- Nutritional counseling
- Active monitoring
