Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy is a widely used, pain-free medical treatment in which, through the use of a specially designed, pressurized chamber, a patient breathes 100% oxygen for a prescribed length of time. The result is an oxygen-enriched bloodstream that promotes healing.

Uses for hyperbaric oxygen therapy include:

- » Diabetic wound in the lower extremity.
- » Osteoradionecrosis.
- » Soft-tissue radionecrosis.
- » Chronic refractory osteomyelitis.
- » Compromised skin grafts.
