- » Diabetic ulcers.
- » Pressure uclers.
- » Non-healing surgical wounds.
- » Venous stasis ulcers.
- » Arterial ulcers.
- » Trauma wounds/ crush injuries.
- » Burns.
- » Gangrene.

- » Compromised skin grafts and flaps.
- » Radiation tissue damage.
- » Osteomyelitis (bone infections).
- » Soft-tissue infections.
- » Osteoradionecrosis.
